What Is NYLT?

The principles taught and used in this course will provide leadership potential in Scouting, school, and life.

The course is designed to provide activities and skills that you will need to become an effective leader in your unit. You will meet other Scouts in the Council and share ideas and knowledge. You will be assigned to a patrol as part of a troop and will camp and participate in activities with your patrol. You will learn effective communicating, teaching, and leadership.
