

## How do I register for NYLT?

Any scout that wants to participate in the NYLT 2017 course and meets the eligibility requirements should complete this registration and submit a deposit of \$25 and a completed scholarship application to Coastal Carolina Service Center before January 15, 2017. The unit can agree to an additional \$25 fee. Applications will be reviewed and a complete information package will be sent if you are selected for scholarship.

## Age and Rank Requirements

The following are the minimum requirements to attend NYLT:

- ⇒ 13 or Older
- ⇒ First Class or Higher
- ⇒ Presently are or going to be leader in your troop
- ⇒ Recommendation by Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor

Scholarships are offered to scouts that have a need for assistance. If they will not be attending the course because of the cost of the course then they should request a scholarship. There is still a \$25 fee for the course if you receive a scholarship. We will make every effort to provide as many scholarships as required since we have individuals that believe this is an important course for youth. Each requestor must complete the scholarship statement on leadership. If we cannot provide all the scholarships requested, an evaluation of unnamed leadership responses will be ranked in order. Decision of the scholarship committee are final.

# National Youth Leadership Training – 2017 Course – Scholarship Form

## What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is a two weekend six day experience conducted by the Coastal Carolina Council designed to provide each Scout with a meaningful experience in Leadership. This experience will enhance his knowledge and create deeper understanding of his roles and responsibilities of being a leader.

The principles taught and used in this course will provide leadership potential in scouting, school, and life.

## What to expect?

The course is designed to provide activities and skills that you will need to be an effective leader in your troop. You will meet other scouts in the council and share ideas and knowledge.

You will be assigned to a patrol as part of a troop. You will camp with your patrol and participate in activities with your patrol. You will learn effective teaching, communications, and leadership.

## Scholarship

Some generous individuals have decided to provide a number of NYLT Scholarships for units. These scholarships will pay \$100 of the \$150 for the course. To earn a scholarship you must register using the scholarship form and attach a 500 word max explanation of how your unit can benefit from your attendance and how you can use the knowledge and skills learned in your future endeavors.

Registration **does not** mean Acceptance in Course

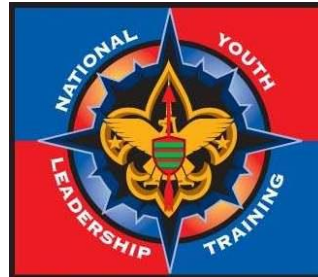
